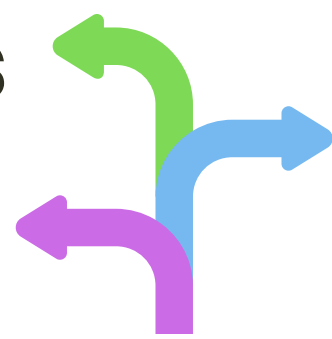


Key Stage 4 Pathways



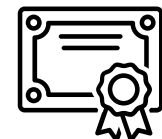
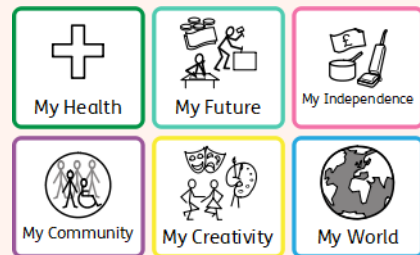
Our 14-19 curriculum focuses on preparation for adulthood, with learning opportunities tailored to individual needs. Key Stage 4 pupils begin their journey towards completing qualifications that will support their transition into further education and/or work. Independence, community participation, health and wellbeing are valuable aspects of learning taught throughout the curriculum, and pupils access weekly lessons themed around six key learning 'areas'.

Our Key Stage 4 curriculum offers a broad range of enrichment opportunities and vocational 'tasters' (for further information please see '14-19 Options').

Purple Pathway

Pupils on our purple pathway are those with the most complex special educational needs and disabilities. They follow a 'pre-formal' curriculum and continue to focus on functional communication, self-regulation and independence in daily life.

Qualifications

Pupils complete a portfolio of units to gain a qualification in **OCR Life and Living Skills**. Units are taken from a range of skills areas; numeracy, communication, ICT, arts and crafts, pre-employability, personal and social skills.

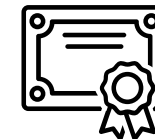
Pupils usually work towards a Certificate or Extended Certificate.

Blue Pathway

Pupils on our blue pathway follow a 'semi-formal' curriculum and are able to access entry level qualifications. They focus on developing independence and key skills linked to life and work.

OCR Entry Level Certificate in Physical Education

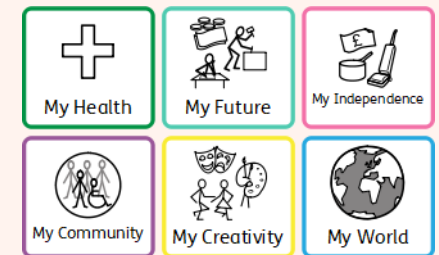

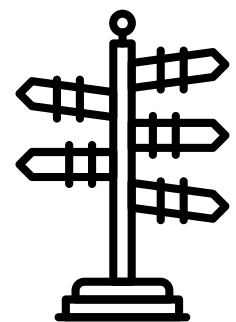
Green Pathway

Pupils on our green pathway are able to engage with a more 'formal' subject-specific curriculum. They are not yet ready to access GCSEs but work towards entry level qualifications. There is a greater focus on applied and work-related learning.
