

Upper School Curriculum

The 14-19 Learning Zone Curriculum has been developed to build on our pupils' previous attainment and prepare them for the next stage of learning and life. The curriculum is zoned into 4 areas informed by the Preparing for Adulthood (PfA) guidance, originally created by the National Development Team for Inclusion.

Our Learning Zones are:

My Future, My Independence, My Health and My Community.

We sometimes create experiences for cross phase learning, however generally Sixth Form students are taught separately to KS5 pupils.

We adhere to the guidance relating to 16-19 study programmes ensuring that all students have an individualised pathway created in accordance with their prior attainment and future goals. Work experience is part of everyone's provision in KS5.

Enrichment opportunities across upper school ensure our curriculum is broad and balanced and reflects the needs and interests of learners. In addition to raising cultural capital and engagement and enjoyment, enrichment brings opportunities beyond the classroom to progress in our curriculum key drivers;

Independence, Wellbeing, Safety and Communication

Pupils in KS4 and KS5 will be following an informal, semi-formal or occasionally a student may require formal learning pathway. All pupils work towards relevant accreditations.
