The initiative has been designed with a focus on building the capacity of teachers and school leaders to improve learning outcomes for young people across a number of 21st Century/ Core Skills areas. At Nethergate we will be focusing on the core skill of Creativity and Imagination.



21st century skills: Global Citizenship

“Education for global citizenship is essentially about equipping young people for the world they will live in as adults. We don’t know for sure what the world will be like in the future but we can have aspirations and help young people to acquire the necessary outlooks, understandings and skills to realise these hopes.”

In February Miss Reading had the opportunity to attend a conference in Jordan to meet Mr Aitouarab a teacher from our new partner school in Morocco, along with many other teachers and school leaders from across Jordan and the MENA region, (Middle East and North Africa). We were able to plan a project with the Moroccan school which will run from March to June. The project will be based around Identity and aims to improve pupil’s understanding of their own identity and how it develops. It will include issues of Gender Equality, one of the United Nation’s seventeen sustainable development goals which have been established with a view to creating a better world by 2030.



Whilst in Jordan we were also able to visit one of the UNWRA schools, which is funded by the United Nations, for Palestinian refugee children in the area.
